## Nancy Gilbert

Nancy and her husband, Richard Wines, donated a conservation easement on their 15 acre property in Jamesport in 2002. The easement protects agricultural land, scenic woodland, wetland and beachfront. Also protected by easement are the facades of their historic house, one-room schoolhouse and barn.

Nancy serves as the chair of the board of the Peconic Land Trust. She is a member of the Landmarks Preservation Commission for the Town of Riverhead, and serves on the advisory board for the Jamesport Meeting House Preservation Trust. She is past president of the East End Arts Council. Raised in Wisconsin, Nancy earned a BA in history from Wellesley College, an MA in Women's History from Sarah Lawrence College, and an M.Phil in American History from Columbia University. After teaching history at the college level, she spent twenty years at JPMorgan in investment banking and human resources.
