Tom grew up in Bellport Village and currently lives with his wife Ellen in Brookhaven Hamlet. He is the Vice President of the Post-Morrow Foundation that works to protect land and the cultural heritage of Brookhaven. He is on the Board of Directors of the Suffolk Network on Adolescent Pregnancy. He has served on the Suffolk County Task Force to Prevent Domestic Violence and the Suffolk County Child Protection Committee for over 25 years.

He is retired from Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk County where he was Director for 6 years. Before Cornell, he was the Director of the Suffolk Community Council for two years and prior to that he served as the founding Director of the Brookhaven Town Youth Bureau for 22 years. He worked in New York City for the Department of Social Services before receiving his Masters Degree in Social Work from NYU. Returning to Suffolk County he became the first Director of Admissions for the School of Social Welfare at Stony Brook University. He was also the Director of the Experimental College at SUNY Stony Brook.

He is a member of the Town of Brookhaven's Open Space Committee and is the Co-Chair of the Carmans River Partnership dedicated to the protection and preservation of the Carmans River.
